## JUNIOR ELECTIVE REQUEST FORM - 2011 - 2012

Below is a list of courses required for every junior attending Kingsway Regional High School. The levels at which your student will be placed will be determined by his or her level of achievement during semester one of this school year.

In addition to these required courses, **your child must choose three (3) electives or two (2) electives and one (1) study hall** to complete the remainder of his or her schedule. The State of New Jersey requires that high school students pass **5 credits in world languages; 5 credits in visual and performing arts; and 5 credits in career education; consumer, family, and life skills; or vocational-technical education** by the time they graduate. Students should fulfill these important and necessary requirements as soon as possible to eliminate any possible scheduling problems that may occur in the future. Please check the *Course Selection Handbook* for specific course prerequisites. **Please also note that the master schedule for the 2011-2012 school year will be set by the end of the 2010-2011 school year. At that time, no schedule changes (including electives) will be considered. It is imperative that both students and parents consider course choices carefully during the scheduling process, as there will be no changes to student schedules except for clerical error.
