SENIOR ELECTIVE REQUEST FORM - 2011- 2012

All students are required to take **English and Health/Physical Education** all four years of high school. In addition, seniors should have acquired **15 credits in history, 15 credits in math (including Algebra I or its equivalent), 15 credits in science, 5 credits in world languages; 5 credits in visual and performing arts; and 5 credits in career education; consumer, family, and life skills; or vocational-technical education** by the end of their senior year. Kingsway requires that students attain a minimum of 116 credits to graduate. Kingsway policy requires that all students take a minimum of 35 credits during an academic year. If your student has not achieved the requirements stated above, he or she has been pre-scheduled into the required classes needed to meet the State standard.

In addition to these required courses, **your student must choose as many as seven (7) electives or six (6) electives and one (1) study hall** to complete the remainder of his or her schedule. The number of electives chosen should be reduced by the number of additional requirements included in the schedule. Below is a list of elective courses offered to seniors. Please note that a student may not take a second year course (i.e. Human Relations II) without having taken the prerequisite course (i.e. Human Relations I). Please check the *Course Selection Handbook* for specific course prerequisites. **Please also note that the master schedule for the 2011-2012 school year will be set by the end of the 2010-2011 school year. At that time, no schedule changes (including electives) will be considered. It is imperative that both students and parents consider course choices carefully during the scheduling process, as there will be no changes to student schedules except for clerical error.
